Step-by-Step Instructions

How to get a permit from the RV and Trailer Parking Permit System

STEP 1: LOG IN

Go to the Permit System page at <https://parking.lakewoodca.gov/>



How to use

1. To create a new account, select 'register now'. Or 'log in now' if you already have an account.
2. If you create a new account, you are required to verify your email address before you can log in. You will receive an email with instructions.
3. Login and create a permit. You will receive an e-mail confirmation of your permit.
4. If you had an account in the old system you will need to [reset your password](#) in order to login.

- **If YES: You just need to re-set your password.** Click on the “reset your password” link, enter the email address you used before, and follow the instructions in the password reset email you will receive. Now you’re ready to log in.
- **If NO:** If you are registering for a new account (you have not had a parking permit account with the city before, including from the old system), **click on the “Register Now”** button. Enter your email address and a desired password to create your account. You’ll receive an automated email message to confirm the account. Click on the link to get to the log-in screen.

STEP 2: CREATE A PROFILE

Now that you're logged in, create your profile. To start, click on the "Select Address" button.

Out-of-town visitors who need a permit to park on the street must visit Lakewood City Hall or the Sheriff's Safety Center at Lakewood Center to request an out-of-town permit.

No vehicles/trailers created yet. Start with [Creating a vehicle/trailer](#) then you can create a permit.

To add a new vehicle to the account, click on Create New Vehicle. Once done, click the "Dashboard" button at the top right to return to the permit home screen.
