PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAKEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO REQUIRED PARKING SPACES FOR REGIONAL SHOPPING CENTERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the City Council of the City of Lakewood concerning a proposed ordinance amending the Lakewood Municipal Code pertaining to required parking spaces for regional shopping centers. This amendment does not affect any specific property within the City of Lakewood and applies to the City generally. The proposed environmental determination is a Categorical Exemption per CEQA Guidelines Section 15061.(b).(3), as there is no possibility that this ordinance will create a significant impact on the environment.
